## Air Cargo Policies & Conditions

### 1. Introduction

All air cargo shipments handled by Libyan Wings Airlines are subject to applicable international and national regulations, including the Montreal Convention and IATA rules.

### 2. Acceptance of Cargo

- All shipments must be properly packed and labeled.
- Shipments must be accompanied by valid documents including Air Waybill, invoices, and required certificates.
- Libyan Wings Airlines reserves the right to refuse any shipment not meeting the requirements.

### 3. Prohibited & Restricted Items

- Weapons, explosives, and flammable materials.
- Dangerous goods unless packed and documented in compliance with IATA DGR.
- Currency, precious metals, and valuable documents unless via special services.
- Live animals or humans remain unless pre-arranged.

### 4. Shipper's Responsibilities

- Accuracy and authenticity of all data and documents provided.
- Compliance with customs and security regulations.
- Bearing any fines or charges resulting from incorrect or incomplete information.

## 5. Carrier's Responsibilities

- Transportation subject to available capacity and operational conditions.
- No guarantee of specific delivery times in case of force majeure.
- Liability limited as per Montreal Convention (maximum [xx] USD/kg).

## 6. Rates & Charges

- Charges are based on the greater of actual or volumetric weight.
- Rates exclude customs duties, taxes, and additional handling charges.

## 7. Insurance

- Libyan Wings Airlines' liability is limited.
- Shippers are advised to purchase additional insurance for full shipment value.

## 8. Delivery & Collection

- Shipments must be collected within [48] hours of arrival.
- Storage fees may apply for delayed collection.

## 9. Claims

- Written claims must be submitted within 14 days of delivery for damage, 21 days for delay, and 120 days for loss.
- Supporting documents must be provided.

## 10. Governing Law

These terms are governed by the laws of the State of Libya and applicable international aviation regulations.
